

<u>Case Study: Mater Academy Lakes</u> <u>High</u>

In spring 2014, the students of *Mater Academy Lakes* in the Miami-Dade County School District had a mean score of 406 on the U.S. History EOC. This score surpassed the mean score of all of the 11th graders within Miami-Dade County School District by 6 points.

During the school years of 2015 and 2016, each 11th grade student in *Mater Academy Lakes* was provided with a *Gateway to U.S. History textbook of his/her own. During these years, Mater Academy Lakes* students surpassed the district's mean score by 13 points (2015) and 19 points (2016).

In 2015, Mater Academy Lakes High purchased 300 copies of Gateway to U.S. History for its 11th grade student body, and in 2016, they purchased 400 copies. From spring 2014 through spring 2016, Mater Academy Lakes High students' overall passing rate climbed from 71% to 84%, and surpassed the Miami-Dade County School District's overall passing rate for 11th grade students in the U.S. History EOC.

<u>Case Study: Doral Academy Charter</u> <u>High</u>

In spring 2014, the students of *Doral Academy Charter High* in the Miami-Dade County School District had a mean score of 411 on the U.S. History EOC. This score surpassed the mean score of all of the 11th graders within Miami-Dade County School District by 11 points. This was followed by strong performance in spring 2015, during which *Doral Academy* students surpassed the district's mean score by 17 points.

In 2014, Doral Academy Charter High purchased 110 copies of Gateway to U.S. History for its 11th grade student body. From spring 2014 through spring 2016, Doral Academy Charter High students' overall passing rate consistently improved, and also surpassed Miami-Dade County School District's overall passing rate for 11th grade students in the U.S. History EOC.


Case Study: New Dimensions High

In spring 2015, the students of *New Dimensions High* in the Osceola County School District had a mean score of 413 on the U.S. History EOC. This score surpassed the mean score of all of the 11th graders within Osceola County School District by 11 points! This was followed by another impressive performance by *New Dimensions High* students in 2016, when their mean score of 424 surpassed the District's mean score by 23 points.

2015, New Dimensions In High purchased one copy of Gateway to U.S. History for each 11th grade student. From spring 2015 through 2016, New spring Dimensions students' overall passing rate dramatically rose from their passing rate of 65% in spring 2014's U.S. History EOC, to 91% in 2016, a 40% increase.

<u>Case Study: G-Star School of the</u> <u>Arts</u>

The teachers and students of *G-Star School of the Arts* in Palm Beach County turned to *Gateway to U.S. History* as their principal printed resource and have seen impressive performances over a 2-year period (school years 2016 and 2017).

In 2015, their 212 students had a mean score of 415. In 2016, their 267 students had a mean score of 420, which was followed by a mean score of 421 in 2017.

In September 2015, *G-Star School of the Arts* purchased 275 copies *Gateway to U.S. History* for their 11th grade student body. From 2015 to 2017, *G-star* students maintained strong passing rates on the U.S. History EOC.

Case Study: Pahokee Middle-Senior

In spring 2014, the students of *Pahokee Middle-Senior* in the School District of Palm Beach County produced a mean score of 379 on the Florida U.S. History EOC. After *Pahokee Middle-Senior* students were provided with one copy each of *Gateway to U.S. History* from 2015-2016, there were significant improvements in their mean scores.

In September 2015, Pahokee Middle-Senior purchased 110 copies Gateway to U.S. History for their 11th grade student body. From spring 2014 to spring 2016, Pahokee students' passing rate improved by 145%.

Case Study: John I. Leonard High

In spring 2015, the teachers and students of John I. Leonard High in Palm Beach County School District turned to Gateway to U.S. History as one of their primary printed sources.

Their mean scores on the U.S. History EOC improved consistently from spring 2014 to spring 2016, going from 391 to 401, a 10 point improvement.
